

## Recitals

Dear Parents,

Although the Holiday Season is just approaching, all of the behind the scenes planning for our Annual Recitals is kicking into high gear! "Stars of Tomorrow 2008" will be held at the new Montgomery Township High School Center for Performing Arts, which is located at 1016 Route 601 in Skillman.

The Kathleen Academy of Dance will divide all of the classes into three (3) troupes, and will be presenting Shows #1, #2, & #3. If you have more than one child enrolled, or a child taking multiple classes, there is a strong possibility that your child/children will be performing in different shows. Each **CLASS** will perform in one show.

### The "Stars of Tomorrow" 2008 Recital Dates are:

4:00 PM  
8:00 PM**

Final completion of all of the show troupes will not be available until early Spring at which time you will be informed of in which show your child's class will perform. In the meantime, please try to keep this date available. **Due to the structure of the schedule, requests for specific recital times will not be accepted.**

The production of the Recitals is an extremely complex task as we strive to produce high quality, well balanced and entertaining shows. Accomplishing this goal requires coordinating many complicated logistics to arrange for facilities, support service, materials, costuming, etc. The composition of the shows requires blending of students of various ages and abilities with dance styles, choreography, music and costumes.

**Specialty Classes such as the Mini, Junior and Senior Kicklines, as well as some of our older, advanced students will perform in every show.**

To insure that all costume orders are delivered to us in time for pictures, dress rehearsals and performances, we must have the completed participation forms and costume deposits returned to the studio no later than **November 30, 2007. This is the DEADLINE!**

Costume deposits are \$50.00/per class. (Costumes range from \$55-\$70 approximately, with certain specialty class costumes sometimes running slightly higher. Balances are due when costumes are delivered to the studio.) Costume deposits are not refundable from the costume companies. If your child drops out of class prior to the end of the season, you are responsible for the costume balance.

**If we don't have your permission form and costume deposit returned to us by Friday, November 30th, and you have not notified Miss Kathleen of your situation, we will then assume that you do not plan to participate in the Recital. A costume will not be ordered for the student and cannot be ordered at a later date. The Studio cannot assume responsibility to contact you if we have not heard from you regarding costume deposits not received by November 30th. If there is a problem, please contact Miss Kathleen prior to this date.**
